WHY SAUDI?

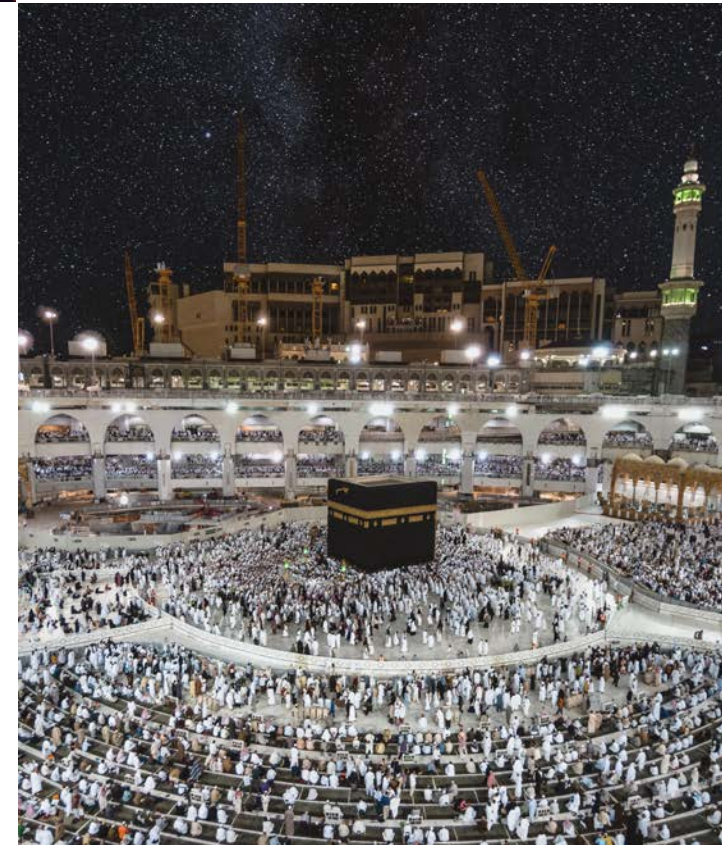
Saudi Arabia is a tax-free country, which means that everything you earn is yours.
